It is the policy of Extended Day that for every 15 minutes your child is picked up after 6:00 p.m. there is a \$25 late fee.

Holidays

Full care is available on many school holidays for an additional fee. It is necessary to pre-register for these holidays. Holiday registration notices will be sent in the Tuesday e-note, prior to the holiday. Please read our weekly updates on the Tuesday e-note that is sent out each week.

The charges for non-Extended Day students will be \$35 for half-day (7:30- 12:00 or 12:00- 6:00) and \$65 for full-day care (7:30-6:00).

Holiday rates are as follows:

\$50.00 per day for Extended Day students
\$65.00 per day for non-Extended Day students

Changes may be made in holiday schedules up to one week before the holiday. After that time, you will be billed for the day whether it is used or not. Staffing is based on the number of students registered.

Lunch and Daily Schedules

Pre-Kindergarten

At noon each day, the Pre-K students will be led to the Extended Day room where they will have a short share/reflection time and then led down to the Kiva for lunch. Your child may bring a lunch each day or may choose to eat in the Kiva. A lunch order form will be sent home each week in your child's Tuesday packet. It is extremely important to fill this form out and return it to school the very next day. If your child has ordered lunch from the Kiva, the teacher will bring their food to the table. (They do not go through the lunch line.)

After lunch, it is off to a quick rest time, outside play, Pre-K Enrichment classes, or activities in the Extended Day room.

Kindergarten

At 3:00, the K-5 children will join the Pre-K and have a snack in the Extended Day room. They will then either go outside or stay in for art activities or center play. At 4:15, all age groups will meet together in a designated place for "4:15 Fun".

Grades 1-4

Students in grades 1-4 will report to the Kiva after the bell rings each day for snack and attendance check. Study Hall will begin at 3:15 and run until 4:15. The children will go to Study Hall with their age group to a designated area. This program is intended to offer students an opportunity to study and complete homework either independently, within a small group, or one-on-one with a teacher after the school. Afterwards, all students will meet for "4:15 Fun".

Monthly Students

Monthly rates are available for 5, 3, and 2 days per week. Parents of students enrolled will need to submit any changes to their schedule, in writing, by the 30th of each month prior to the change. If your child stays beyond the scheduled checkout time, you will be billed for the additional time at the rate of \$25.00 per 15 minutes after our 6:00 p.m. close.

Drop-in Students

Drop-in programs provide Hammond parents' greater flexibility. The drop-in rate for Extended Day is \$10.00 per hour. You must be registered in the Extended Day program in order to participate in this service. *Advanced 24-hour notice is required. If advance notice is not given, a \$5 charge will be added to your bill. To use this service, please notify Extended Day by any of the following: Call the Extended Day office #776.0295 ext. 2005.

Health and Safety

We take our responsibility for the health and safety of your children very seriously. We ask parents to return to the Extended Day office health and emergency release authorization forms and discipline signature pages before the beginning of the school year. These forms can be found online or you can pick them up in the Extended Day office. If your child has been previously enrolled in our Extended Day program, you will still need to fill out these forms. Extended Day does not require separate immunizations & physical exams. This information is kept on file in the Extended Day office. All of our staff has current certification in Basic First Aid and Child CPR. Emergency procedures and evacuation plans are in place in case of any emergency. If your child needs medication, it will be administered by the school nurse. Extended Day staff does not administer any medication to children.

It is our responsibility to know where all Extended Day children are after school. If a child in grades 1-4 does not check in after school dismissal, an Extended Day supervisor will check with the school office and the classroom teacher, and then call the parents. If your child is registered to attend Extended Day and will not be present, please notify the Extended Day office before noon. If calling after noon, please call the Lower School Office.

Enrichment Classes and Enrollment

The enrichment classes provide an opportunity for students to develop skills and interests in a variety of areas. Enrollment in after-school enrichment classes is offered to all Hammond students in grades Pre-K-6th. Pre-K students whose participation in Extended Day is limited to one enrichment class should register for "Enrichment Plus". Enrichment Plus is for students not enrolled in full time Extended Day, but who are enrolling in one of the Enrichment classes. The cost of Enrichment Plus is \$60 per month plus the monthly class fee. The \$60 per month fee covers the time between 12:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m. one day a week.

Hammond reserves the right to cancel any class for which there is not adequate enrollment. Enrollment for all enrichment classes will be on a "first-come, first-served" basis, so register early! Class enrollment is for one month minimum and the class may be dropped after the month. The Extended day office must be notified of any changes to your child's enrichment classes and prior to dropping a class. Classes may only be dropped after the last class of each month. Please refer to the descriptions of enrichment classes for more information on each class.

ALL ENRICHMENT CLASSES WILL BEGIN AFTER LABOR DAY, THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 6th.

Billing and Policies

The Business Office bills Extended Day families on a monthly basis. We bill at the beginning of the month for the prior month. Extended Day families can expect to receive their bill by the 10th day of the month.

Any questions regarding monthly statements should be directed to the Business Office at #776.0295 ext. 1029.

It is the policy of Extended Day that for every 15 minutes your child is picked up after 6:00 p.m., there is a \$25 late fee.

Any changes made to your child's schedule must be submitted in writing by the 30th of each month prior to the change. These changes should be submitted to the Extended Day office.

A \$5 charge will be added to your bill when 24-hour notice is not given for drop-in childcare.

You may not switch your registered days unless it is a school holiday. Requests must be made 24 hours prior to the holiday.

Drop-in rates will apply if you pick your child up 10 minutes or later after their enrichment class concludes. This does not apply to enrichment classes prior to 3:00. Children not picked up 10 minutes after the conclusion of carpool will be sent to Extended Day and charged a drop-in fee of \$10.00 per hour. Enrichment Classes may be dropped after the last class of each month and you must notify the Extended Day office two weeks prior to dropping or adding a class.

Pre-Kindergarten Clothing

Please send a complete change of clothes for your child to keep in their homeroom. Label all clothing and place in a bag marked with your child's name. These clothes are not required to be Hammond uniform, but similar. These clothes may be the same items, which are required by your child's homeroom teacher.

*We have an open door policy and parents have full access to their children at any time during Extended Day operating hours, unless there is a court order limiting parental access.

*A child will only be released to the adults that are authorized for pick up on the child's registration form. Upon pick up, the adult must check in with the supervising caregiver and be cleared through the sign out sheet. If someone else will be picking up the child, the Extended Day staff must have a signed note with the name, in order for the child to be released. The person should be prepared to show proper identification before we release the child.

*Extended Day will not release any children to any unauthorized person under any circumstance.

Enrichment Classes!

(Classes Begin the week of September 6th)

The following were classes that we offered in the past and may or may not be offered this school year. A finalized list of classes, days, and fees will be posted in early August. Please check the website for updates of our Enrichment classes.

Cooking

Instructor: Joy Bethea

This class is an introduction to the basics of cooking and baking. Learn how to read a recipe and correctly measure ingredients while making yummy and nutritious treats. *Please let either Joy Bethea or the Extended Day know ahead of time if your child has any special food allergies!

Golf

Instructor: George Bryan's Golf Academy

Students have the opportunity to learn the basic skills of golf as well as to reinforce already developed knowledge of the game. George Bryan is a well known pro in the area with many years of experience to his credit. Students are expected to bring their own set of clubs each Wednesday and leave them in the breezeway between Lee and Marion Hall.

ACT (Action Cheer and Tumble)

ACT is a non-competitive program designed for young girls who wish to learn tumbling and cheerleading skills. For the past 18 years, Pam and her staff have instructed girls in a safe, positive, energetic, environment throughout the state of S.C. Stories and Art

You will see a developmental evolution in your child in language skills, literacy, listening, problem-solving, social skills, self-esteem, and musicality. We work 1 on 1 in class on your child's ear and rhythm response.

Tennis

Each Friday afternoon you are invited to join Bob and Doug in learning the fundamentals of "The game of a lifetime." Bernie and members of the Varsity Boys' and Girls' Tennis Team will be assisting Bob and Doug, schedules permitting. The focus will be on fun and fundamentals, and will be a great introduction to anyone wanting to learn more about the game.

Fun Bus

Instructor: Fun Bus Staff

The Fun Bus mission is to enhance learning and enrich the lives of young boys and girls by providing a safe and FUN environment where they can build self-esteem, improve attentiveness, awareness, and gross motor skills through physical fitness and social interaction. The specially designed, climate controlled bus comes to Hammond bringing a different curriculum each week using tumbling mats, parallel bars, trampolines, balance beams, punching bags, rock walls, rings, trapeze, swings, climbing ropes, tunnels, balls, beanbags, parachutes, musical instruments basketball hoops, and much more!

Study Hall

Instructor: Extended Day Staff

Students participating in study hall report to the Kiva once the bell rings for a quick snack and then head over to the library or designated rooms for supervised study. This is mandatory for all 1st-6th graders who are not in enrichment classes, but staying in Extended Day. Students enrolled as “monthly” or “drop-in” Extended Day students paying monthly or drop-in fees are automatically enrolled in the study hall program. Please pick your child up promptly at 4:15 p.m. If he/she is only registered for study hall, otherwise drop-in rates will apply.

Soccer

Instructor: Adrian Pinasco

Join our Varsity Soccer coach and Lower School P.E. teacher every Wednesday. Coach Pinasco brings a lifetime experience of playing and teaching the fundamental skills and techniques of the game. In addition, this program will offer your children the opportunity to exercise and improve their overall physical fitness through an environment full of games and laughter. Soccer experience is not required, just a hunger for learning and enjoyment.

Hip Hop

Instructor: Abigail Smith

Learn dance combinations used in “Hip-Hop” style dance style. Develop the strength, flexibility, rhythm, leaps, turns, balance, and combinations in the center and safe body mechanics to dance confidently in a social atmosphere. This style of dance is known for fast, athletic movements and body isolations, unlike the fluid movement of ballet.” Hip-Hop” is extremely popular and can be seen in commercials, music videos and concerts, but is choreographed “age appropriate” and tame. There is a recital at the end of the year at no extra charge.

Tap/Ballet

A perfect combination class. The class is divided into tap as well as ballet. Since ballet is the basis for all dance technique, the combination of both work hand in hand. The technical training is taught through ballet, which in turn helps teach the proper shifting of weight and patterns in movement for tap. Since children naturally respond to music and movement, all the activities are executed to fun music. There will be a recital at the end of the year at no extra charge.

Kids’ Broadway

Kids Broadway (3rd and 4th graders) is for budding singers who want to have fun learning the basics of singing and performing age-appropriate selections from hit Broadway shows. Dr. Lynch has taught K-12 music and collegiate voice for over twenty years. Her goal is to teach students how to make a beautiful tone and sing with expression and confidence.

Let’s Sing Broadway
