



## Senior Statistics Class of 2010

- The senior class of 2010 graduated 63 students.
- Members of the Class of 2010 were accepted to 84 schools in 21 states and the District of Columbia.
- They will attend 26 schools in 12 states.
- Seventy percent accepted offers of admission in state while 30% will pursue their undergraduate degrees out-of-state.
- Five members of the class were recognized by the National Merit Scholarship Competition. Four were named *National Merit Commended Scholars* and one was named a *National Achievement Outstanding Participant*.
- There were 28 scores of 700 or higher on the Critical Reading, Math, or Writing sections of the SAT.
- The average SAT score (Critical Reading and Math combined) posted by the Class of 2010 was 1225.
- Fifty-eight percent of the class scored 1200 or above on the SAT (CR & Math)
- Fifty-six members of the class (89%) took 189 Advanced Placement exams before completing their Hammond diplomas
- Forty-seven percent of the class took three or more AP classes prior to graduating.
- Twenty-nine percent of the class took five or more AP classes prior to graduating.
- Thirteen percent were named South Carolina *Palmetto Fellows*, the state's highest scholarship award. The majority did so by posting GPA's of 4.00 and SAT's of 1400/above.
- Eighty-four percent of the class was offered academic scholarships in excess of \$4.6 million.
- Six members of the class of 2010 earned GPA's of 4.5 or higher and were awarded the distinction of Honor Graduate.
